Novice Stakes: Confined to dogs which have not gained a 1st, 2nd, 3rd, or 4th award in a 24 Dog Open Stake, a 1st, 2nd, 3rd award in a 12 Dog Open Stake: or a 1st in an All Aged or Novice Stake.

Open: Dogs, which have gained an award above. Preference in the draw being:

- (a) Members dogs with an appropriate award
- (b) Non members dogs with an appropriate award
- (c) Members dogs gaining other awards
- (d) Non members dogs gaining other awards
- (e) Other dogs

All Aged: Preference in the draw given to members dogs.

Entry Fees: Open; members £50.00 non members £90.00
A/A & Novice; members £35.00 non members £70.00

Regulations:

1. Dogs entered at Kennel Club Licensed Field Trials must be registered at the Kennel Club in accordance with Kennel Club Regulations for Classification and Registration B.
2. Preference in the novice draws will be given to those not previously offered a run in a novice stake that season. Substitutions will be allowed provided conditions apply.
3. All dogs resident outside the UK must be issued with a Kennel Club Authority to Compete number before entry to the show/event can be made. All overseas entries without an Authority to number will be returned to the exhibitor/competitor.
4. If entries or nominations exceed the number of permitted runners the right to compete in a Trial shall be decided by ballot.
5. Should circumstances so dictate the Society in consultation with the judges may alter arrangements as necessary. Such changes and the circumstances surrounding them will be reported to the Kennel Club.
6. No modification may be made to the schedule after publication except by permission of the Kennel Club followed by an advertisement in the appropriate journals if time permits before the closing of entries.
7. Judges at a Trial are prohibited from entering a dog which is recorded in their ownership or part ownership.
8. **DOGS IN CARS ON HOT DAYS:** Your dog is vulnerable and AT RISK if left in a vehicle in high temperatures and even on days considered as slightly warm. Please take care of your dog.
If your dog is found to be at risk forcible entry to your vehicle may be necessary without liability for any damage caused.
9. **Welfare of Dogs:** An exhibitor or competitor whose dog is entered at a Kennel Club licensed event should take all reasonable steps to ensure the needs of their dog(s) are met and should not knowingly put their dogs health and welfare at risk by any action default omission or otherwise. A breach of this Regulation may be referred to the general Committee for disciplinary action under Kennel Club Rules and Regulations.
10. Videography and photography will only be allowed with the express permission of the chief steward and the host.
